\$10,000 College Scholarship Introduced for Goddard School Grads

2008 winner exemplifies spirit of company founder

King of Prussia, Penn. (May 27, 2008) – Goddard Systems, Inc., today announced the winner of a new, first-of-its-kind annual scholarship program.
