

THE GODDARD SCHOOL: GOING FOR THE RECORD

FORT MILL TOWNSHIP – The Goddard School co-owner Amy Strickland played the role of “Simon” as the Gold Hill Road school joined other Goddard branches nationwide in an attempt Friday to set the Guinness World Record for the most people playing Simon Says at once (it would be the multi-venue record). Students, their parents, Fort Mill firefighters, Fort Mill Police Dept. Lt. Ray Dixon, school staff and the Maggie Moo’s cow mascot – 36 in all – participated.

Travis, 4, was the site winner among students. Sites have a week to submit their official Guinness records, with the organization then working through the application to see if a new world record was set.
