Campers will need to bring a packed lunch with an ice pack on field trip days. No heat-ups permitted. The Goddard School provides morning and afternoon snacks.

Summer registrations are on a first-come, first served basis. **We fill up quickly!** There is a non-refundable activity fee. Campers do not need to be enrolled during the school year to enroll in Summer Camp.
