- o Applicant must be a graduate of a Goddard School Pre-Kindergarten and/or Kindergarten program. Goddard Systems, Inc. may verify the information provided by the applicant.
- o Applicant must be a high school senior who is a U.S. citizen, a permanent resident or a non-U.S. citizen living legally in the United States.
- o Applicant must provide one 30- to 120-second video addressing the question, "How did your Goddard School experience influence your career path or education?" Video size should be 1280x720 pixels; we strongly recommend against compressing your videos. Videos longer than 120 seconds will not be eligible for consideration and the application related to them will be considered incomplete. Video essays should be saved to a USB drive and mailed with the completed application.
- o The written essay and video submitted with each application must be the original work of the applicant, and may not contain the work, including the intellectual property, of others (including non-original music).
- o Applicant must submit a transcript from all high schools attended with his/her application. Transcripts must indicate a cumulative GPA.
- o A completed application must be submitted by mail and postmarked by March 13, 2020. Incomplete applications (applications that do not have completed and signed application, written essay, video and transcript(s)) will not be considered.

 - o The recipient must use the scholarship to study or train at an accredited college or university of the recipient's choice, including vocational and technical training programs or associate and bachelor's degree programs.

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- o The scholarship finalists will be selected based on their academic records, participation in school and community activities, honors, work experience, expressed goals and aspirations and the videos they submit.

 - o Information relating to the Committee's evaluation of any applicant will be confidential.

 - o The three finalists for the scholarship will be selected and notified on April 2, 2020.
 - o Finalists will be announced on Goddard System, Inc.'s social media accounts on April 22, 2020. From there, one winning scholarship recipient will be selected and announced on May 1, 2020.
 - o The application and all parts of the application package submitted will not be returned to applicant.
