COMBONI GROUNDS (NEXT DOOR)

During the summer we take over neighboring Comboni's west facilities and fields. Comboni is the "home-base" for our school-age campers.

All campers have access to Goddard grounds, as well as the Comboni grounds, kitchen, and full-sized gym throughout the day!



GODDARD GROUNDS



Our Goddard School campus includes large classrooms, science/cooking center, covered patio, and gym. Campers will also enjoy the outdoor classroom and outdoor sport court for basketball, four square and more! This is in addition to 3 playgrounds with plenty of space for kickball, soccer and outdoor sports.

DISCOVERY CAMP

Ages: under 5 years old

This camp includes our traditional Goddard School curriculum that stimulates social-emotional growth and supports core STEAM skills. Engaging outdoor visitors, weekly water days, and fun summer activities are aligned to weekly camp themes. Activities are safely conducted on Goddard's main campus and playgrounds.

Camp Options: Full and half-day schedules available, 2-5 days / week. Enroll by the month or by the week.

EXPLORER CAMP

Ages: 5-6 years old

Structured for students about to enter Kindergarten and ready to start exploring the world! This camp follows the Discovery Camp schedule; including engaging outdoor visitors, weekly water days, and age-appropriate field trips. Explorer Campers are based within Goddard School's main campus with walking trips to our Comboni summer campus.

ADVENTURE CAMP

Ages: 6-8 years old

Designed for school-agers with an even wider variety of adventures and environments! This camp includes traditional Goddard curriculum, engaging outdoor school visitors, water days, high-energy summer activities, and fun field trips each week. Adventure campers have access to Goddard School's expanded summer campus with a full-sized gym and large fields. Campers will participate in specialty Mini Camps each week.

QUEST CAMP

Ages: 8-10 years old

In addition to regular Adventure Camp activities and multiple Mini Camps and field trips, we also tackle more involved projects and build valuable character traits...all with the emphasis on having FUN! They have their own, separate base camp at Comboni, with a full-sized gym, large fields, and loads of age-appropriate games and activities.

No heat-ups permitted.** The Goddard School provides morning and afternoon snacks.

REGISTRATION BEGINS MARCH 6

Summer registrations are on a first-come, first served basis. **We fill up quickly!** There is a non-refundable registration fee of \$75/child for families not enrolled for the normal school year. **Campers do not need to be enrolled during the school year to enroll in Summer Camp.** Schedule changes for your camper after registration are possible with two weeks advance notice.
