
GODDARD GROUNDS

DISCOVERY CAMP

Ages: under 5 years old

This camp includes our inquiry-based Wonder of Learning curriculum that stimulates social-emotional growth and supports core STEAM skills. Engaging visitors, weekly water days, and fun summer activities are aligned to weekly camp themes. Activities are conducted on Goddard's main campus and playgrounds.

Camp Options: Full and half-day schedules available, 2-5 days / week. Enroll by the month or by the week.

EXPLORER CAMP

Ages: 5-6 years old

Structured for students about to enter Kindergarten and ready to start exploring the world! This camp follows the Discovery Camp schedule including engaging visitors and weekly water days, with the addition of age-appropriate field trips. Explorer Campers are based within Goddard School's main campus with walking trips to our Comboni summer campus.

SCHOOL-AGE CAMPS

Ages: 6-10 years old

Designed for school-agers with an even wider variety of adventures and environments! These camps include engaging visitors, water days, high-energy outdoor summer activities, and fun field trips each week. Campers have access to Goddard School's expanded summer campus with a full-sized gym and large fields. Campers also participate in specialty Mini Camps each week.

There are three school-age camps organized according to age and ability: Adventure, Journey and Quest camps. They each have their own space, follow the same general schedule, and experience the same field trips, visitors, and mini-camps. Camp Counselors structure daily activities to accommodate the interests and abilities of each camp group.

Camp Options: 2-5 days / week

Cost: Full-day 5 days/week is \$315/week (7am-6pm). Includes all activities, visitors, mini camps & field trips. A 10% discount on older sibling's camp cost.

HOURS

Camps are from 9am - 4pm. We include extended before and after camp care from 7am - 6pm at no additional charge!

LUNCH / SNACKS

Discovery and Explorer campers have the option of catered lunches on non-field trip days only for an additional fee of \$4.00/day. Our catered lunches are nutritionally balanced meals. Adventure & Quest campers will be on-the-go each day and need to bring a packed lunch with an ice pack every day. No heat-ups permitted. The Goddard School provides morning and afternoon snacks.

REGISTRATION BEGINS MARCH 4

Summer registrations are on a first-come, first served basis. **We fill up quickly!** There is a non-refundable registration fee of \$100/child for families not enrolled for the normal school year.

Campers do not need to be enrolled during the school year to enroll in Summer Camp. Schedule changes for your camper after registration may be possible with two weeks advance notice.
