

## HOURS

## GODDARD GROUNDS

Campers enjoy access to our huge 8 acre summer campus, whether their home base is our main Goddard School grounds or our expanded Comboni campus. The full campus includes large classrooms, covered patio, two gyms, outdoor classroom and outdoor sport court for basketball, four square and more! This is in addition to 3 playgrounds with plenty of space for kickball, soccer and outdoor sports.



## REGISTRATION

Summer registrations are on a first-come, first served basis. We fill up quickly! There is a non-refundable registration fee of \$100/child. # SCHOOL-AGE CAMP

Designed for school-agers with an even wider variety of adventures and environments! These camps include engaging visitors, water days, high-energy outdoor summer activities, and fun field trips each week. Campers have access to Goddard's expanded summer campus with a full-sized gym and large fields. Campers also participate in specialty Mini Camps each week. There are three school-age camps organized according to age and ability: Adventure, Journey and Quest camps. They each have their own space, follow the same general schedule, and experience the same field trips, visitors, and mini-camps. Camp Counselors structure daily activities to accommodate the interests and abilities of each camp group.

**Camp Options:** 2-5 days / week

**Cost:** Full-day 5 days/week is \$365/week (7am-6pm). Includes all activities, visitors, mini camps & field trips.

Step into a world of dragons, legends, and imagination!


Campers will create magical stories and showcase their creativity in a fun end-of-week performance.

## Snacks & Meals

Morning and afternoon snacks are provided. Most campers bring a packed lunch each day.

Discovery and Explorer campers may order catered lunches on non-field trip days for \$4.00 per day.

Monthly sign-up required in advance with Ms. Bekkah.

Adventure, Journey, and Quest campers must bring a packed lunch with an ice pack each day (no reheating).

## What to Bring: (please label all items with first & last name)

- Closed-toe shoes
- Water bottle (filled & ready each day)

### Explorer & School-Age Camps:

- Change of clothes for spills or accidents (including underwear!)
- Packed lunch w/ ice pack
- Backpack or tote
- Towel & dry clothes for water day

### Discovery Camp:

- 2 changes of clothes for spills or accidents (including underwear)
- Milk for lunch
- Nap mat
- Towel & dry clothes for water day

## Billing:

Camp tuition is payable through ACH, check, or cash (no credit cards). Flexible tuition options are available by the week if camp attendance is scheduled/ adjusted the month prior. Statements are sent for review prior to ACH being withdrawn on the 5th.
