Thank you!</p>	<p>Signed Field Trip Permission Forms and Waivers are required before the start of camp. Links for completing waivers are provided in your summer camp packet.</p> <p>Students should wear comfortable shoes and socks for every Field Trip. Camp t-shirts and camp wristbands are provided and required for every Field Trip. We will launder the t-shirts after each trip, so they are ready for the next one.</p> <p>Sunscreen and sunglasses or a hat for outdoor venues are strongly recommended.
